Dear Parents/Carers

As part of their topic, 'Back to the Stone Age' children in Skylarks class will visit Butser Ancient Farm on Wednesday 5th November 2025.

This trip will give the children the opportunity to experience and take part in a variety of Stone Age activities that replicate real life back then. This will begin with a tour of the Ancient Farm with a learning talk whilst sitting inside a replica Stone Age building! Then the children will be able to enjoy a variety of activities and workshops throughout the day. These will include Archaeology, Jewellery Making and Wattleing.

The cost of the trip will be a voluntary contribution of £20.00 per child.

- Butser Ancient Farm = £14.00 per pupil
- Cost of travel - £180 = £6.00 per pupil

Children will need to bring a packed lunch, including a drink to be carried by themselves in a rucksack or lunch bag.
